

APPLICANT TRENDS - APPLICANTS

Graphs making five-year comparisons of fall term applicants:

The fall term represents the largest number of applicants and is used in comparisons.

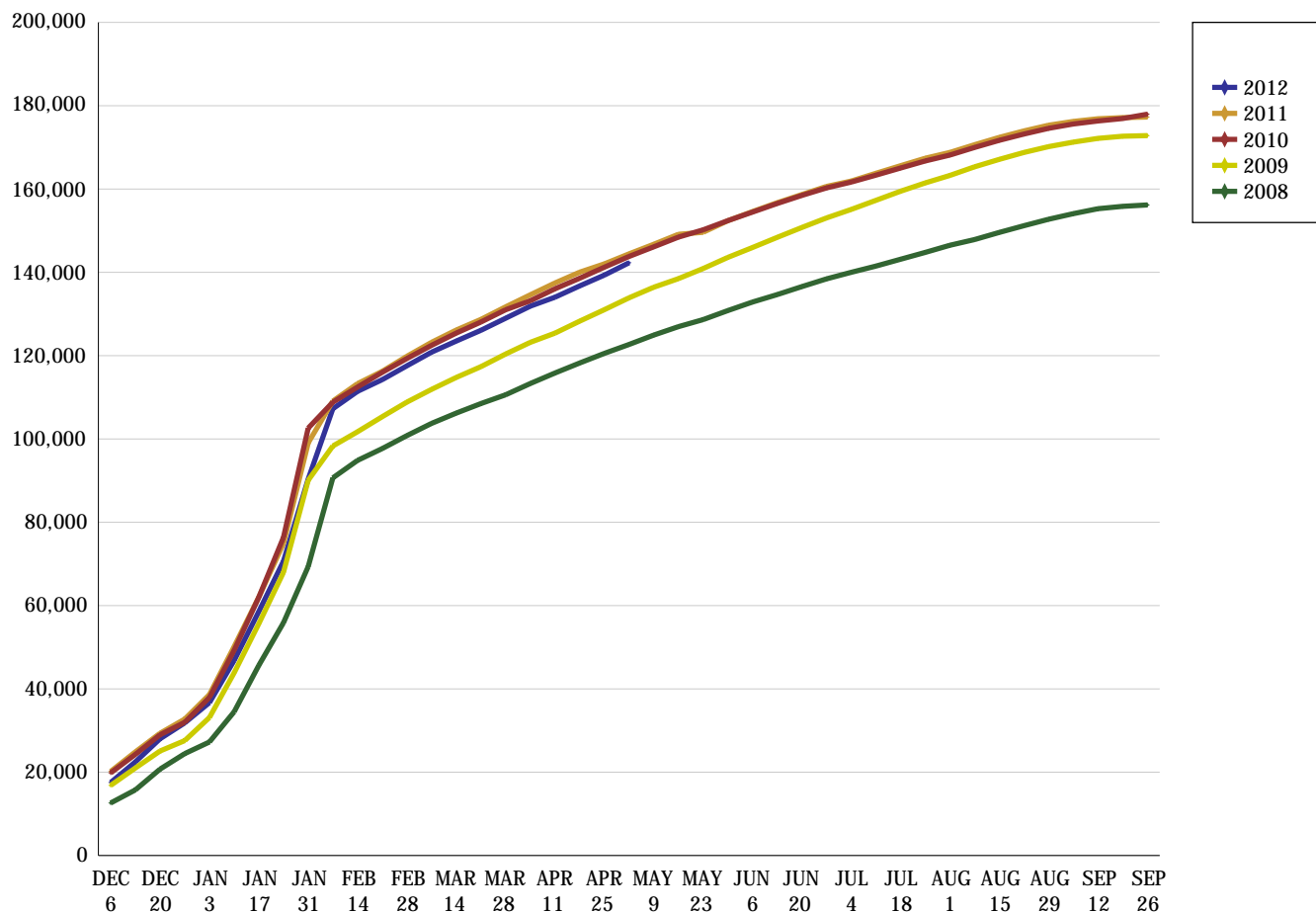
The first graph shows all applicants, followed by graphs showing the breakdown for direct (secondary) and non-direct (non-secondary) applicants.

A direct applicant applies to college directly from high school (applicant is taking one or more high school level courses through day school, night school, summer school or correspondence).

The graphs are updated monthly, and weekly between January and February.

Total Fall Applicants as of May 1, 2012

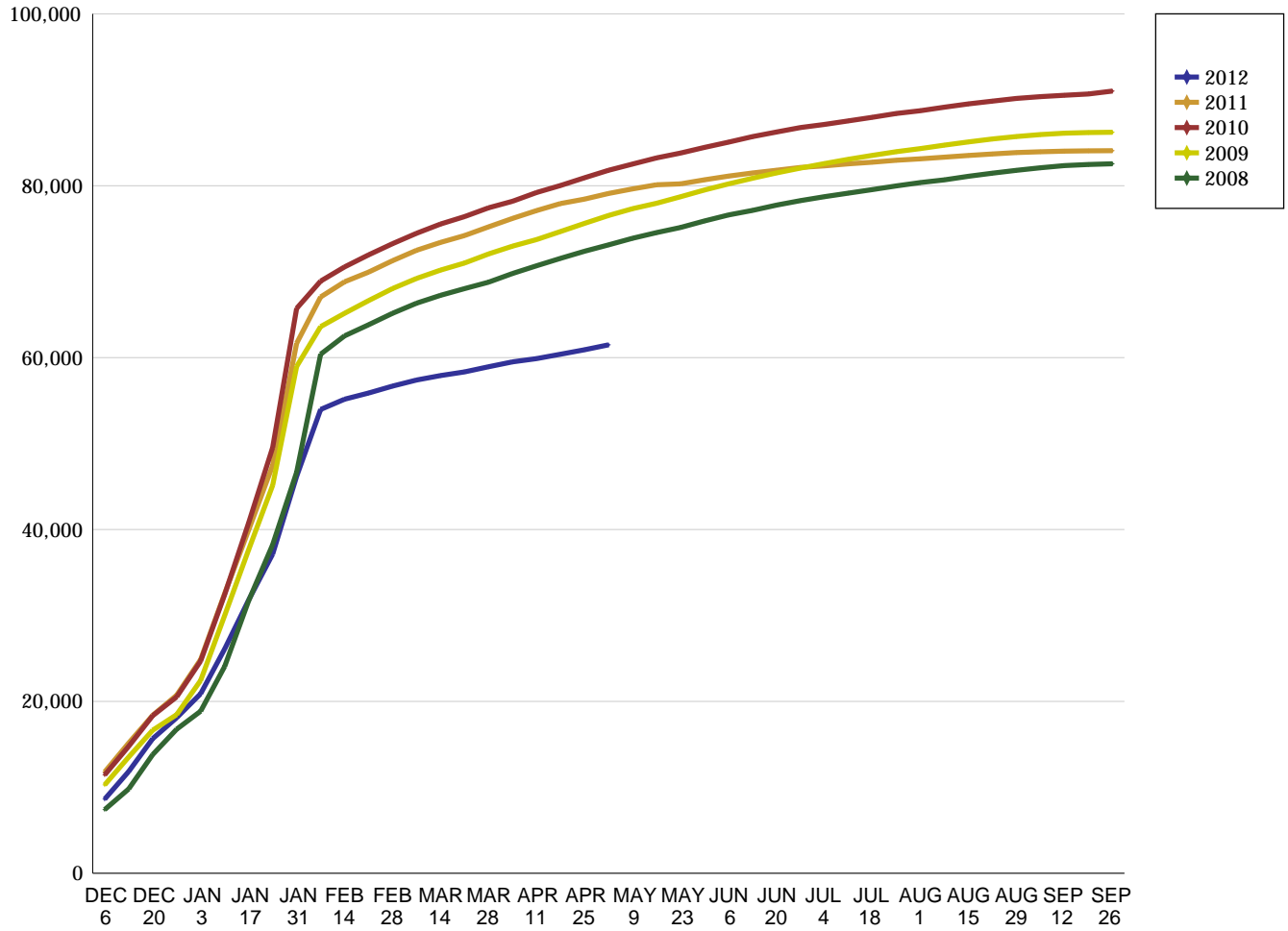
Down 1.5% (-2,137) relative to the same time in 2011
